Welcome to the Central Baldwin Middle School Band program! We are very proud of our band program here at the middle school and are glad that you have chosen to be a part of our tradition of excellence. Our program consists of over 240 students. Our ensembles include 7th grade concert band, 8th grade concert band, Jazz Band and Pep Band. The CBMS band program has a rich history of outstanding achievement. The band program has earned superior ratings at the yearly Alabama Bandmasters Music Performance Assessment (state assessment) and many of our students have been selected for County, District, and Alabama All-State Honor Bands.

ENSEMBLES

7TH GRADE BAND

This performance-based class is composed of 7th graders or students just beginning band that did not participate in 6th grade. Performances include district/state assessments and winter/spring concerts. These students continue to work on understanding of basic music literacy, instrument maintenance, proper posture and playing position, and development of characteristic tone quality through exposure to daily exercises and musical literature.



8TH GRADE BAND

This performance-based class is the middle school's most advanced performing ensemble for wind and percussion instrumentalists. This class is composed of 8th graders that are introduced to comprehensive musicianship through performance of challenging and varied literature. Skills and concepts from the previous year are developed and expanded upon. Students will continue to refine their musical skills and knowledge of musical literacy. Performances include district/state assessments and winter/spring concerts.



PEP BAND

This band is composed of 7th and 8th graders that perform at football games, pep rallies, and other events such as Open House, Orientations, and much more!



ATTENDANCE POLICY

- Our goal here in the CBMS Band is 100% attendance, 100% of the time.
- Attendance for ALL concerts, performances, and after-school practices is **mandatory and graded**.
- Please contact Mr. Collins in the event of an absence.
- Excused absences include, but are not limited to :
 - Personal Illness
 - Family Death or Illness
 - Other School Function
 - Family Planned Trip
 - Other: Please contact a Band Director directly
- In the event of an excused absence, the student will be given a makeup assignment.
- In the event of an unexcused absence, the student will receive a zero.

CLASS PROCEDURES/RULES

- No food or drinks allowed in the band room, unless specified. (Water is the only drink allowed in the band room).
- Come prepared with your method book, sheet music, and instrument everyday!
- Our main rule here : ***Always show a manner of respect for any teacher or peer in the classroom.***
- HAVE FUN!!

CLASS FEES/FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

- ALL students are required to pay a \$75 class fee.
- The fees will cover the cost of their band shirts that are used for pep band performances, their method book, sheet protectors, transportation for state assessments, and other needs for the band.
- The CBMS Band has **TWO fundraisers** each year!
 - Fundrays Fundraiser (Coupon Books and Online Items)
 - Students are **REQUIRED** to sell **atleast** one item. (Students are encouraged to sell as many items as possible!) This helps keep our band fees as low as possible!
 - Your student can “opt-out” of the two fundraisers by paying \$40 directly (\$20 per fundraiser) to the CBMS Band. Students will not be required to sell or participate in the fundraiser if this fee is paid .

PEP BAND/CONCERT BAND ATTIRE

- For ALL concerts, students will be dressed in “concert black”. Students have two options:
 - Black dress (school appropriate per Baldwin County guidelines) with black shoes / socks if needed.
 - OR
 - Black slacks, black long sleeve button down, and black shoes / socks if needed.
- For ALL pep band performances, students will wear the CBMS Band t-shirt, school appropriate shorts/pants, and shoes.
- ***Southern Performances will be coming by to fit our students for Concert attire. We highly recommend ordering through them!***

GRADING

1. Summative / Formative Assessments (60%)
 - Playing / Written Tests
 - Concerts
2. In Class Grade (30%)
 - Bringing all supplies to class everyday.
3. Out of Class Grade (10%)
 - After-School Rehearsals
 - Bringing instruments home every Friday.

PRIVATE LESSONS

- Private Lessons are not required, but are highly recommended for all students in the CBMS Band Program.
- Private Lessons are one-on-one, individually designed lessons that cater to the student’s needs to further their success on their respective instrument.
- Students will not only study the applied music from their class in these lessons, but also music for other opportunities, such as All-County, All-District, All-State, and Solo and Ensemble Festival. (Participation in Honor Bands is HIGHLY recommended! Students receive instruction from prestigious current/former band directors or musicians who are brought in to clinic these groups).

RECOMMENDED INSTRUMENT MATERIALS

FLUTE:

Tuning rod, cleaning swab, polishing cloth

OBOE/BASSOON:

At least two reeds at a time and reed cases, case for water (35MM film case works well), cork grease, and cleaning swab.

B FLAT SOPRANO & BASS CLARINET:

Blue Box Vandoren strength 2.5 or 3 reeds, reed guard/case, cork grease, and swab.

ALTO, TENOR, & BARI SAXOPHONE:

Blue Box Vandoren strength 2.5 or 3 reeds, reed guard/case, cork grease, swab, and neck strap.

TRUMPET:

Valve oil, mouthpiece brush, polishing cloth, cleaning snake brush, and tuning slide grease.

FRENCH HORN:

Valve oil, mouthpiece, mouthpiece brush, polishing cloth, and tuning slide grease. Students playing this instrument should also purchase their own mouthpiece if using a school owned instrument.

TROMBONES:

Slide oil, mouthpiece brush, polishing cloth, cleaning snake brush, and tuning slide grease.

BARITONES & TUBAS:

Valve oil, mouthpiece brush, polishing cloth, and tuning slide grease. Students playing these instruments should also purchase their own mouthpiece if using a school owned instrument.

8TH GRADE PERCUSSION:

Stick/Mallet bag with snare sticks, timpani mallets, and keyboard mallets. Name must be on everything!!

CBMS BAND CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT PLAN

Classroom Expectations

- The student will be prepared for class each day with all necessary items.
- The student will not disrupt class in any manner (talking loudly, arguing with teacher, throwing items, etc.)
- The student will always show a manner of respect to all peers and teachers.
- The student will respond diligently to all tasks provided during class.

Classroom Discipline Consequences

- The student will have the following consequences, if they do not follow the above expectations, in this order :
 1. Verbal Warning
 2. Parent Contact
 3. Parent/Student/Teacher Conference
 4. Student office referral
 5. Potential removal from CBMS Band Program (Up to the discretion of administrators and band directors depending on the severity of offense)

Note : Certain behaviors that undermine the safety and well-being of our school will be immediately referred to the administration for appropriate disciplinary action. We aim to foster a safe learning environment for all students.
